Call for Applications for Joint and LLM Educational Programs - Mobility 2019-2020

This call is open to LUISS students enrolled in the 4th year of the the Single Cycle Master's Degree in Law in the academic year 2018-2019.

The following programs will be open to students enrolled in the relevant Major as specified in the Appendix 3 of this document.

A. GENERAL RULES

Selected students will have the possibility to attend courses and take their respective exams both at LUISS and at the partner university. If compliant with both universities' rules and conditions, as for credits envisaged, attendance, deadlines, academic integrity, etc., participating students will obtain the above-mentioned title on top of their LUISS Master's Degree in Law.

Selected students will spend abroad the 5th year of their Single Cycle Master's Degree in Law during the a. y. 2019-2020 and will be registered at LUISS during their stay at the partner university. Depending on the program, students may be required to pay additional tuition fees at the partner university (check point C), but they will continue paying tuition fees to LUISS.

All expenses related to the participation in the program, notably transport, accommodation and food, administrative expenses, expenses associated with securing a visa, medical/health/accident insurance, books and personal expenses, will be borne by students.

Selected students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the program.

Exams passed at the partner university during the mobility period will be transferred to the LUISS career according to the program study plan. It is not possible to request an official renounce of the registration.

B. COMPATIBILITY

B.1. Compatibility among the LLM/Joint Programs

Eligible students are allowed to apply to a maximum of four (4) JEP/LLM Programs among those included in this Call for Applications and will rank the programs according to their preferences at the moment of application. Please note that this preference is completely binding and cannot be changed after the application has been correctly submitted.

Students will be selected for only one JEP/LLM Program within their list of preferences and will be removed from the selection procedures of the other JEP/LLM Programs.

Students who are not selected for any JEP/LLM Program can remain in the waiting list of more than one JEP/LLM Programs. If they are recalled from the waiting list of any program (regardless of their preference) and they confirm their participation, they will be subsequently removed from the other waiting lists.

Refusal or missing confirmation of the JEP/LLM Program selection in compliance with the rules explained in paragraph H. Acceptance implies the official withdrawal from all the JEP/LLM Programs for the a. y. 2019-20.

B.2 Compatibility with the International Student Exchange program

Eligible students are allowed to apply to these programs and the International Student Exchange program.

Students participating to both Calls who will be selected for the JEP/LLM Program must confirm their participation to the program within the established deadline as detailed in paragraph H. Acceptance.

If selected students confirm their participation to the JEP/LLM Program, they will be automatically excluded from the selection for the International Student Exchange program and will be removed from the candidates list.

If selected students do not confirm their participation to the JEP/LLM Program according to the rules explained in paragraph H. Acceptance, they will remain in the candidates list for the International Student Exchange program.

Students who completed an International Student Exchange program during the II, III and IV years are eligible to apply to this Call.

D. REQUIREMENTS

Eligible students can apply if, within the official extraordinary Winter exam session of the a. y. 2018-19 (December 2018 - February 2019), they comply with the requirements for each JEP/LLM Program they intend to apply to specified in the Appendix 1 and 3 by the application deadline.

Students will be able to participate only if they are in regular time frame and have no pending administrative issues with LUISS.

Only for LUISS students taking part in an international mobility program (Erasmus, Exchange) during the 1st semester of the a. y. 2018-2019 for whom the grades have not yet been registered into their student careers¹: the average grade considered for this selection procedure will be the one available to the Student Office by the deadline of the call.

Students who took part in an international mobility program in the previous years are allowed to apply.

E. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications can be submitted **from January 7th until February 1st, 2019 at 12.00**

In order to apply, students must complete the application form and upload the required attachments in the web self-service area of the LUISS website. Only applications accompanied by all documentation and received by the application deadline will be considered.

¹ The registration of the exams taken during the mobility period depends primarily on the partner universities timing.

F. SELECTION

An Academic Commission nominated by the Dean of the Department of Law will select students on the basis of a non-disputable evaluation.

The selection follows a 3-step process:

Step 1: The eligible candidates will be ranked after the analysis of their academic performance (credits and weighted average grade, each weighting 55% and 45%). The Academic Commission will rank eligible students and create the short list for the next step. The academic performance will be calculated on the basis of the data available to the Student Office by the end of the Winter exam session 2018-2019. Candidates are responsible to check its accuracy in due time.

Step 2: An interview will be carried out by a member/member of the Academic Commission and by the International Development Office **on February 20th, 2019** (tbc). The interview will focus on the motivation, the academic background and the previous international or professional experiences and is a key part of the selection process. In case a candidate is not considered suitable for the program, he or she will not be selected regardless of the academic performance, the positioning in the applicants ranking and the number of available slots.

Step 3: The partner Universities will receive from LUISS the short list of candidates already ranked by the LUISS Commission with their dossier. The partner Universities, analysing the LUISS Commission ranking and the candidates' dossiers, has the right to establish the final ranking.

G. PUBLICATION OF RESULTS

The selection results will be communicated by e-mail to the applicants **by February 23th, 2019**.

H. ACCEPTANCE

Selected students will be required to confirm their acceptance through written notification within one working day from the publication of results.

In case of refusal or missing notification by the deadline, the following candidate in order of waiting list will be recalled. Recalled students will be required to confirm their participation by written notice within one working day.

Every refusal received after the established deadline will be transferred to the Vice Rector for Teaching who will evaluate its motivations with the Dean of the Department and the Director of Teaching, Research and Employability, and will inform the Graduation Commission of those refusals deemed not properly motivated.

I. ADDITIONAL POINTS

The participation in a JEP/LLM Program will provide additional points to the Final Grade of the Master's Degree, according to [LUISS rules](#).
